Oleander	Nerium oleander	All parts	Humans, pets	Vomiting, irregular heartbeat, death
Lily of the Valley	Convallaria majalis	All parts	Humans, pets	Heart arrhythmias, hallucinations
Foxglove	Digitalis purpurea	Leaves, flowers, seeds	Humans, pets	Visual disturbances, heart issues
Monkshood	Aconitum napellus	All parts	Humans, livestock	Tingling, paralysis, death
Autumn Crocus	Colchicum autumnale	All parts	Humans, pets	Organ failure, respiratory distress
Daffodil	Narcissus spp.	Bulbs	Humans, pets	Vomiting, convulsions
Hydrangea	Hydrangea spp.	Leaves, flowers	Humans, pets	Nausea, cyanide symptoms
Angel's Trumpet	Brugmansia spp.	All parts	Humans, pets	Hallucinations, paralysis
Calla Lily	Zantedeschia spp.	All parts	Humans, pets	Oral irritation, vomiting
Larkspur	Delphinium spp.	All parts	Humans, livestock	Muscle tremors, death
Bleeding Heart	Dicentra spectabilis	Roots, foliage	Humans, pets	Tremors, convulsions
